**APPLICATION** - deadline October 9, 2024

#### *Eligibility*

- ◆ Will be a sophomore, junior, or senior next year (2024-2025)
- ◆ Students' previous conduct will be considered in determining eligibility
- ◆ Not currently on college or academic probation
- ◆ Students on leave term are eligible to serve

#### *Expectations*

- ◆ Participate in trainings to prepare for service
- ◆ Serve with other students, faculty, and staff (max 3-4 hearings/term)
- ◆ Hear Standards of Conduct and Academic Honor Policy cases (and occasionally registrarial appeals)
  - Hearings are held remotely (Zoom) on Monday or Thursday afternoons
- ◆ Protect confidentiality of students and organizations involved in cases
