## Prevention Education Advisory – Extreme Cold

**#1** Water damage is the most frequently reported claim in the FPMA Property Program

Call your heating contractor **immediately** if there is a problem with the furnace and take immediate action to prevent further damage.

Turn the heat down to no less than 60 degrees — **don't turn the heat off!**

If a local undergraduate or alumnus/a can't be counted on to check on the house while it is empty, hire someone to do it for you over the break periods!
