COMMUNITY FUND

The NAP Community Fund was established to provide support for programs and events that are an expression of the Native American Program's values and promote community building.



Individuals or Dartmouth-recognized student groups may apply.



NAP's contributions range from \$25 - \$750 per event, if approved.



Proposed event date must be at least 1 week after the review meeting.



Applications are due by 12:00pm EST on Mondays and review meetings are scheduled for the following Tuesday.

▶ Funds may not be used for charitable donations, alcohol, personal expenses, or prior expenses. No reimbursements are granted.

▶ The fund will open Week 2 of each term. The final submission deadline is the Monday of Week 8.
