MOVE OUT DEADLINE IS WEDNESDAY, JUNE 8 @ 12 NOON

DEADLINE FOR GRADUATES IS MONDAY, JUNE 13 @ 12 NOON

Please make appropriate plans and follow the instructions below. Anyone found in a residence hall or who has items left in their room or hall after the deadline will be subject to a \$100.00 fine and further disciplinary action.

TIP: Begin packing well in advance of your expected departure date. Be aware that Office of Residential Life staff will be entering every room on June 8th for non-seniors (unless all residents have interim housing in their spring term room) and June 13th for graduating seniors, for the purpose of making sure that the residents have left for the spring term and have followed the closing procedures. Please provide your departure information in the checkout form available on DartHub, Housing StarPortal. This will help custodians with cleaning rooms and will be important to know if there is an emergency situation that necessitates knowing who may be in the building. Place items in controlled storage early. Locations fill up quickly. We offer limited controlled storage on a first-come, first-served basis. See the reverse side for detailed information. You must have everything out of your room and halls, even if you are waiting for storage. Remove all items from common areas and from the Trunk Room. Anything that is left will be removed by the College and you will be charged for storage and the labor to move the items. The College is not responsible for anything that is left in the common areas. Take recycling & trash from your room to the hallway garbage cans and recycling areas. Please remove all personal furniture and items from your room. Double check your drawers, closets, and other hiding places for items left behind. The college is not responsible for anything left behind in your room. Clean your room. If it is left in such a condition that requires more than a routine cleaning, a minimum fee of \$50.00 will be assessed. RETURN YOUR ROOM KEY...to a key drop box using a room key envelope. Failure to return your key by 3pm on June 8th (or by June 13th for graduating seniors) will result in a lock change and a charge to your Da\$h account for \$55.00; there is a \$15.00 charge for not using a key envelope.

IMPORTANT THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW WHEN STORING ITEMS:

- Controlled Storage does not accept large pieces of furniture including, but not limited to, mattresses, futons, sofas, or chairs. Mini-fridges, lamps, rugs, and TVs are accepted.
- Controlled Storage costs are \$15.00 an item per term. Your student account will automatically be charged if you are not registered for a term.
- Controlled Storage is only available for students who are not enrolled for classes in Hanover and are away from campus for the term. You may store your items in Controlled Storage for the interim if you are on the following term, but your items MUST be removed within 3 weeks from the beginning of the term.
