WHO CAN VOTE IN HANOVER?

**IF YOU ARE 18, A U.S. CITIZEN, AND A RESIDENT OF
HANOVER, YOU CAN VOTE HERE. NOTE THAT IF YOU
LIVE IN SUMMIT ON JUNIPER OR SACHEM VILLAGE
AND WANT TO VOTE IN NEW HAMPSHIRE, YOU MUST
VOTE IN LEBANON.**

VOTING FAQs

SHOULD I VOTE IN MY HOME STATE OR NEW HAMPSHIRE?

IT'S UP TO YOU! SOME THINGS TO CONSIDER ARE HOW CLOSE YOU FEEL TO THE COMMUNITIES AROUND YOU. IF YOU FEEL A GREATER SENSE OF BELONGING IN YOUR HOME STATE RATHER THAN IN NEW HAMPSHIRE, VOTE IN YOUR HOME STATE.

YOU SHOULD ALSO KEEP IN MIND THAT BY VOTING IN NH, YOU'RE INITIATING A CHANGE IN RESIDENCY. IF YOU ARE RECEIVING A SCHOLARSHIP THAT REQUIRES RESIDENCY IN ANOTHER STATE, YOU SHOULD CHECK WITH THAT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM BEFORE CHANGING YOUR REGISTRATION.

HOW CAN I VOTE IN MY HOME STATE?

YOU CAN REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT HERE:

IF YOU NEED TO PROVIDE A REASON FOR VOTING OUT OF STATE, MOST STATES ACCEPT YOUR STATUS AS A COLLEGE STUDENT AT AN OUT-OF-STATE UNIVERSITY AS A VALID EXCUSE. VOTING FAQs

HOW DO I REGISTER TO VOTE IN NH?

THERE IS A VOTER REGISTRATION DRIVE ON JANUARY 8 FROM 3-5 PM OUTSIDE COLLIS COMMONGROUND! IF YOU MISS THIS DRIVE, YOU CAN 1) REGISTER ANY WEEKDAY AT HANOVER TOWN HALL OR 2) REGISTER TO VOTE ON ELECTION DAY AT THE POLLS.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

WHETHER AT THE POLLS, TOWN HALL, OR AT A DRIVE, BRING:

- DRIVERS LICENSE OR DARTMOUTH ID
- PASSPORT OR BIRTH CERTIFICATE (OR A PHOTO OF EITHER)
- IF YOU LIVE OFF-CAMPUS IN HANOVER, BRING A CURRENT, SIGNED LEASE OR UTILITY BILL FOR YOUR PROPERTY

WHO'S RUNNING?

24 CANDIDATES ARE RUNNING TO BE THE REPUBLICAN PARTY'S NOMINEE FOR PRESIDENT AND 21 CANDIDATES RUNNING TO BE THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY'S NOMINEE.

IF YOU'RE ALREADY REGISTERED WITH ONE OF THE TWO PARTIES, YOU WILL BE GIVEN THAT PARTY'S BALLOT AUTOMATICALLY AT YOUR POLLING PLACE.

IF YOU HAVE NOT YET REGISTERED WITH A PARTY, YOU WILL BE ABLE TO CHOOSE WHICH BALLOT YOU'D LIKE TO FILL OUT AT THE POLLS. NOTE THAT WHICHEVER PRIMARY YOU CHOOSE TO VOTE IN BECOMES THE PARTY THAT YOU ARE REGISTERED WITH. ADDITIONAL ACTION IS NEEDED TO REVERT BACK TO UNDECLARED.

NOT ALL CANDIDATES' NAMES ARE PRINTED ON THE BALLOT FOR SOME PRIMARIES. HOWEVER, YOU CAN CHOOSE TO WRITE IN A CANDIDATE'S NAME.
