Accommodations

Guests are invited to stay in College residence halls. As undergraduate residences, they do not offer the amenities found in a hotel, but their convenience to on-campus events makes them a popular housing option.

The <u>application process</u> becomes available on February 29 at 8:00 a.m. EST and can be found at <u>www.dartgo.org/housing</u>. Applications must be completed by **Monday, April 1 at 11:59 p.m.** EST.

Housing assignments will be made after the application deadline. Guests whose applications are submitted after the application deadline will be housed if space is available.

Residence hall rooms are available for occupancy from 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Friday, June 7, until 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 9. The College is not able to accommodate guests on Thursday or Sunday night.

Students who are graduating may retain their own rooms until 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Monday, June 10. Early graduates (and their spouses/partners) who are returning for commencement and plan to stay in residence halls will be guests of the College and will not be charged for their rooms. They must return an application by April 1.
