Each year, Dartmouth welcomes students who are close to finishing their graduation requirements to participate in the commencement ceremony. Our records indicate you will not complete your graduation requirements by the end of the 2024 spring term, but you will have completed between 31-34 credits at the conclusion of this term, making you eligible to participate in commencement.
